## Action Steps

### How can you join the movement?

#### Listen and Learn

Educate yourself on the realities of the prostitution, sexual exploitation, and the policies that impact prostituted individuals.

#### Spread the Word

Spread the word about upcoming webinars, seminars, and conferences through social media, emails, newsletters, blogs, etc.

Create a social media campaign to share news and educational articles that support partial

Write an Op/Ed piece to your local newspaper on why you support SH4All.

#### Attend Events

Attend and invite others to attend webinars / conferences / workshops / seminars

#### Share Your Resources

Share your time, funds, talents, and resources with organizations in your local community that fight against human trafficking, exploitation, sexism, and all forms of interpersonal and state-based violence.

#### Connect with Law Enforcement

Meet with your local police department, county sheriff's office, and county attorney's office.

Ask them to publicly support partial decriminalization / SH4All, if they have not already.

Ask them what their current model is for victim-centered responses and offender accountability.

*Who are they arresting, charging, and diverting - victims or buyers? Share why offender accountability and demand stings are needed as well as the harmful impacts of criminalization and diversion on victims.*

#### Have Conversations

Talk with your family, friends, co-workers, and neighbors about SH4All and why you support it. Encourage them to connect and have conversations with people in their spheres.

Meet with political, civic, student, issue-based, faith-based, philanthropic, or service organizations to educate on SH4All and ask for their public support.

#### Contact your Legislators

Meet with, call, or write your local, state, and federal elected officials to let them know you would like partial decriminalization implemented in Minnesota.

#### Create a Petition

Create a petition and gather support for partial decriminalization.

#### Shift the Culture

Address societal conditions that accept exploitive culture and victim blaming.

This means we need to reframe how we view choice and responsibility. Instead of critiquing victims' choices - we need to hold offenders 100% responsible for their actions.

*For example, no matter what a person wears, how much alcohol they consume, etc. it is the responsibility of the other person NOT to violate, assault, rape, or exploit. That choice is the responsibility of the offender, not the victim. No person deserves to be violated, assaulted, raped, or exploited.*
